COMMISSIONING AT A GLANCE

The Commissioning Process at PowerHouse Church is a secondary discipleship track that follows the Discipleship Process. It is the second phase of our leadership track of discipleship at PowerHouse Church. While everyone who gets commissioned is not required to or may not step into a leadership role, every leadership role at PowerHouse has a requirement for that leader to be commissioned.

The process can take anywhere from 1 to 2 years and is designed to be completed with a mentor. During this process the expectation is to see growth in maturity, character, and faithfulness.

The idea of commissioning is that every person that completes the process is now commissioned to take another person through the same process. Our aim is to make disciples who will then be able to make more disciples.

Commissioning involves the completion of reading 9 books (Youth, 3 books), and completing the corresponding workbooks and essays. Refer to the Commissioning Curriculum section for the book list.

REQUIREMENTS TO ENTER

To enter the Commissioning Process, the candidate must be recommended by a commissioned mentor.

The candidate must have completed the Discipleship Process.

The Candidate must meet the following requirements:

- Attended PowerHouse Church for one year
- Exemplify mature christian character
- Must have a desire to mentor and disciple others
- Must be an All In church member (Attend, Serve and Tithe)
- Must attend an Encounter God Weekend before graduation

DURING THE PROCESS

To maintain your All In Status - Commissioning candidate must be Attending, Serving and Tithing for a minimum of 6 months consistently.

Must Remain Accountable to Mentor

Must complete 9 books (Youth, 3 books) + workbooks and essays

Must complete 3 full day mission trips or outreach events

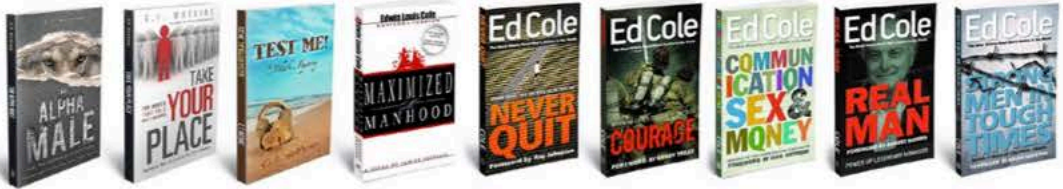

Must be able to purchase all books, workbooks, sword/shield and Encounter Fees.

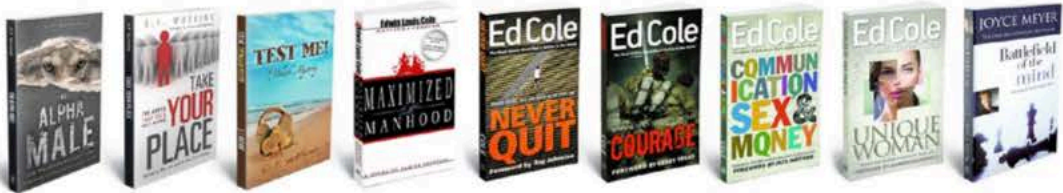

- 1 You do not complete the curriculum and assigned work at the assigned time.
- 2 You are unresponsive or unaccountable to the mentor and the commissioning process.
- 3 You stop attending, serving or tithing.
- 4 You are involved in any type of sexual sin, alcohol or drug abuse, in the middle of any court cases such as: foreclosure, divorce, repossessions, taxes, etc.
- 5 Completing the work is not the only qualification needed to receive a sword/shield. We reserve the right to make judgments based on the character of the individual.

COMMISSIONING CHECKLIST

- Review Commissioning Packet with mentor.
- Complete required reading, exams and essays for each book.
- Consistently tithe and contribute to the Jordan Ranch Partnership.*
- Consistently serve at PowerHouse Church/Gen180.
- Go on 3 full-day missions trips or outreach events prior to May 1st.*
1 full-day at Jordan Ranch is required.
- Attend an Encounter God Weekend at Jordan Ranch / Youth Camp.
- Turn in payment for sword, shield or dagger by May 1.
- Turn in curriculum (exams and essays) to your mentor.
- Prepare to participate in the commissioning ceremony.
