
Every believer is charged with making disciples who can then make disciples themselves. God's intention is multiplication.

#### **HOW IT WORKS**

The Discipleship Process is designed to be walked through with a mentor. The goal of this process is growing in mature christian living, strengthening your devotion and increasing your understanding of the christian faith and life. You will work through and complete a series of two workbooks which have daily assignments. As you complete the daily work you will have meetings with your mentor.



To start the Discipleship Process, first find a mentor. This relationship should be as organic as absolutely possible. You want to connect with someone who has some experience beyond your experience. You want a mentor to whom you give permission to hold you accountable. If at any time you need help in finding a mentor, feel free to contact church leadership and we will help you connect with someone.

#### **WAYS TO FIND A MENTOR**

Here are some ways to organically build relationships to connect with a mentor.

- Attend our weekly meetings like ManChurch,
  Awaken and Sunday services. This will give you
  access to people who are like-minded and desire
  to grow in the scriptures.
